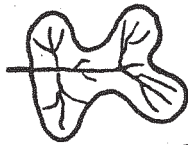

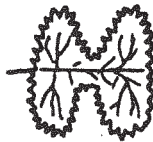

samaras = any kind of small winged seed

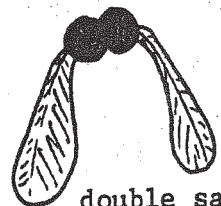
